5 Achieving Best Value

Learn how to ensure that your school is achieving best value with the procurement of goods and services.

6 Capital Funding (E-Learning)

All about your capital allocation and the processes involved in spending capital funds to improve buildings and ICT.

7 Reducing the Risk of Fraud

Learn about the processes and controls that can be implemented to help protect your school against the risk of financial irregularities and fraud.

8 Managing Your Staff

This module covers the important topic of HR with practical guidance on how to effectively manage your school staff and work with Contracts of Employment.

9 Financial Returns (E-Learning)

Learn about the importance of checking and authorising month end reports and other financial returns made throughout the year.

10 Schools Financial Value Standard

In this course you will learn what evidence can be requested by the Governing Body to provide them with assurance that the new Schools Financial Value Standard is being met.

The School Finance Administration Programme has been specifically designed to provide school finance staff with the financial skills and knowledge needed to effectively administer finances within schools.

The programme consists of the following courses:

Introduction to School Finance

An overview of school finance including funding, budgeting, roles and responsibilities and financial systems used within Norfolk schools.

2 Star Foundation

Basic training on how to use the school financial accounting system for raising orders, processing transactions and running month end.

3 Accounting for Expenditure

In-depth training on purchasing regulations, raising orders, accounting for VAT and recording individual transactions as well as how to fix common problems that occur.

4 Income & Banking

All about raising standard invoices, accounting for VAT, banking income and chasing for bad debts. Includes how to fix common problems that occur.

5 Month End

Learn about downloads, bank reconciliations and how to check month end reports. Includes more detailed training on how to fix common problems experienced with month end.

6 Year End

Practical based training on what to expect at Year End and how to undertake the tasks involved to ensure your school accounts are properly closed down.

7 Petty Cash (E-Learning)

Learn all about operating a petty cash tin in your school, including the procedures you should be following, and how to use Star Accounts to record, reconcile and top up your tin.

8 Purchasing Cards (E-Learning)

This module covers everything you need to know about using and administering Purchasing Cards in schools.

9 VAT For Schools

An interactive course that tackles the sometimes complex area of VAT. Lots of practical advice from the NCC Tax Manager to help you properly account for VAT at your school.

10 School Fund

Everything you need to know about the School Fund Account! The course includes best practice guidance on appropriate expenditure, VAT, audit and using Star Accounts.
