






Choose Your Future

November 28, 2013, 9.30 - 2.30 at the Norfolk Showground



The event is the first of its kind for Norfolk and is free and open to any young person in year 9 and upwards.

Bringing together growing industries key to the economic success of our county, the convention is hosting companies from the Energy, Engineering, Construction, and Manufacturing sectors and organised into zones

allowing students to focus on areas in which they have an interest.

The Norfolk County Council funded Careers event, run in partnership with Build Norfolk and oil and gas training provider OPITO, will showcase 60 to 70 leading companies with industry experts and recent recruits on hand to explain the types of skills required

and how to enter each industry sector.

Interactive activities. spanning all four sectors. include:

- · Hands-on engineering and technical challenges
- A computer based ship's bridge simulator will be equipped with a joy stick control which will allow students to steer a vessel through a variety of situations
- · Wiring (circuit boards) will be available for young people to assemble and connect
- Plumbing visitors will practice bending pipe to fit in clips to radiators and sinks and fit taps to sinks
- · Mechanical engineering dismantle and assemble a hydraulic pump
- Emergency response kit for students to try on and a marine life raft which they will be able to go inside and learn about sea survival
- A demonstration on the use of CAD and 3D modelling software
- A Lego robot which visitors will be able to control and programme, helping them understand how computing and engineering are interlinked
- Students will be able to sit in a race car and drive around a track using an interactive racing game projected onto a screen

Over 2,000 students, 20 schools and 100 teachers have already booked, with limited spaces still available.
