Totally Tudors KS2 or KS3

Experience what life was like for rich and poor Tudors in the age of Norfolk's rebel, Robert Kett.

Enjoy and learn with live re-enactors and hands on sensory experiences.

Myths, Legends and Dragon's Lairs KS1 or KS2

An adaptable, creative cross curricular day to inspire your students through storytelling, drama, hands on history, science and crafts.

A HERITAGE SPECIAL: Norwich Discovery Trail KS2 or KS3

Visit three important historic buildings to investigate what they can tell us about the past. Each venue provides an insight into a different facet of Medieval and Tudor Life: homes and spiritual places of Mayors and Merchants, the importance of the River Wensum and the medieval trading environment and economy of Tombland and the King Street area.
