



Child Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC)

Norfolk's SARC, 'The Harbour Centre' has developed a new service, to support children under the age of 13 who have been sexually assaulted.

The service that will be delivered by a Child Advocate has been developed to support children, young people and their families with practical and emotional support throughout the criminal justice process.

Helping Children and their families to understand what has happened, prepare for the next steps and to arrange further support that the child or wider family may benefit from.

Families can expect:

- Face to face contact / telephone contact.
- A direct contact / liaison point with the police.
- Regular updates on the investigation.
- Practical and emotional support before, during and after court trial.
- Arranged pre-trial court viewings.
- Resources, websites & booklets about the Criminal Justice System.
- Signposting opportunities
- Advocacy throughout the entire process, including support at meetings, such as at School or with social Services.
