

The Harbour Centre is here to help you

We are here to help

The Harbour Centre is a sexual assault referral centre, where specially trained professionals can help anyone who has been raped or sexually assaulted.

How can we help?

You can speak to a Crisis Worker who can give you support and talk through your options

You can talk to the police, if you want to – but you don't have to, this is your choice

We can talk to the police on your behalf, and can do this anonymously

You can have a medical examination on site where we can secure forensic evidence

You will be offered ongoing support from an Independent Sexual Violence Advisor

You can talk to someone about counselling to help you through these difficult times

It is up to you if you want to see us. All you need to do is phone for an appointment before visiting. You don't need to report the assault to the police or see your GP first; you can call us 24 hours a day.

Do I have to talk to the police?

You don't have to talk to the police. However, Norfolk Constabulary has worked with local Primary Care Trusts to set up The Harbour Centre, so if you do decide, at any time, to talk to police, you can ask one of our Crisis Workers to arrange this.

The right people to help you

All our staff are highly skilled and trained to deal with people who have been raped or sexually assaulted. They can offer initial and on-going support.
