Request for assessment

The LA consider the request and decide whether to make a statutory assessment

The LA carry out an assessment and decide whether or not to issue a **Statement**

The LA Issue the proposed **Statement** or explain their decision not to make a **Statement** and issue a note in lieu

If the LA has decided to issue a **Statement**, it will send out the final **Statement**
