Greg Brooks, Professor Emeritus at Sheffield University, who will be talking about evidence based interventions for children and young people, referring to his recently revised publication: 'What works for pupils with literacy difficulties? - The Effectiveness of Intervention Schemes'.

Dr Graham Sibley was a Director of the Thetford Education Action Zone from 1999 to 2003, he currently leads on grant-supported research, including Catch Up Numeracy interventions and digital games, and will talk about what works for children with mathematical difficulties based on A. Dowker's research.
