Early Talk Boost – is a targeted and evidence-based intervention programme, which supports language delayed children aged 3-4 years to make progress with their language and communication skills. The training will give participants the skills and knowledge to;

2. Identify appropriate children for the intervention programme
3. Measure their progress
4. Deliver the intervention successfully

Early Talk Boost training is designed for early years practitioners working with groups of 3-4 year olds in early years settings.
