During the spring term the Education Library Service is offering **five** half hour library consultation sessions free of charge. Sessions will be booked for the first five schools to get in touch requesting a visit.


You can use these sessions to get advice on a planned library refurbishment, to get a quick overview of your current library provision or just to find out more about the services the ELS offers.

PAPER TEXTS BEAT DIGITAL DEVICES FOR LEARNING AND COMPREHENSION – THAT'S OFFICIAL!

A meta-analysis (Educational Research Review vol. 25 November 2018 by Delgado, Vargas, Ackerman and Salmeron) on the effects of paper versus digital media on reading comprehension, has found that across all age groups the former gives much better results.

Drawing on more than 54 studies of 171,055 participants from age 10 to adult, the results were decisive, particularly with non-fiction, either informational or mixed informational and narrative. The title of their research says it all: 'Don't throw away your printed books'!

There are some fabulous non-fiction books being published, which we buy and will include in our project boxes for your schools. Every topic box is created bespoke for your school, so simply let us know what you need and for what ages, and you may use the resources for a term.
