The Learn Equality, Live Equal programme is a FREE 12-week, 3-step approach that provides evidence of impact. The programme is fully funded by the Government Equalities Office, delivered by the Anti-Bullying Alliance and the Sex Education Forum.

Learn Equality, Live Equal has been designed to ensure a realistic approach for schools to embed an impactful, whole-school approach. The programme can be led by any member of staff including SLT, PSHE Lead, Pastoral Support of TAs. Participating schools will have access to an Expert Advisor throughout.

What's included?

- 4 focused CPD training sessions for 2 members of staff, with access to online CPD training for all staff
- Digital tools and resources to support a whole-school approach, log actions and measure progress
- Access to an expert advisor who will support you to review and change school policies, curriculum, and practises to develop an inclusive school.

What are the benefits?

- Develop an evidence-based strategy to reduce HBT bullying, and promote inclusion
- Readiness for statutory Relationhsips Education and Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education
- Proactive approaches to mental health issues affecting LGBT young people
- Compliance with the Equality Act 2010
- Evidence the involvement of parents pupils and staff in addressing HBT bullying
- Contributes to whole school SMSC, British Values, SIAMS and Ofsted.

Can I participate?

- Have an interest in creating an LGBT-inclusive school
- Nominate a programme lead
- Send at least 1 member of staff to each of the 4 CPD training sessions
- Introduce policies and monitoring procedures to address and prevent HBT bullying
- Have not previously participated in Government-funded anti-HBT bullying programmes in the past 3 years.

Step 3: Review
