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Summer Deaf Festival May 2019

This year the Summer Deaf Festival was held on two days – Friday 24th May and Saturday, 25th May. It was the first time the festival had extended over two days and it appeared to be a great success for everyone involved.

There were many exhibitors, including VSSS, all under one roof at the same time so it was easy for people to look at a wide range of information about services to local deaf people.

Many of the children and young people we support were involved in the signed song performance on the Friday, demonstrating a real sense of confidence in their ability to sign in public. Lots of people commented how moving they found the children's performances and admired their confidence and skills in using sign and music together to such great effect. The whole day had a real buzz of excitement.

The Saturday was a more adult day as there were no school groups but there was still plenty of excitement, not least near the Hearing Dogs for the Deaf stall which appeared to be much more interesting than the VSSS stall for some reason!

In preparation for the festival, a group of Deaf children and young people had taken part in a craft activity, making a "Cabinet of Deafness" which is now on display in the VSSS foyer at Woodside Road.

Level 1 Certificate in British Sign Language

This course is available for professionals, parents and carers.

BSL Module 101: 10 weeks including exam

September 23rd, 30th

October 7th, 14th, 28th

BSL Module 102: 10 weeks including exam

January 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th

February 3rd, 10th, 24th

BSL Module 103: 10 weeks including exam

May 4th, 11th, 18th

June 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd (exam retake) 29th (103 exam)

Venue: The Professional Development Centre, 148 Woodside Road, Norwich (parking is available on site).

Cost: Limited places for a parent of a deaf child at a reduced cost of £80, £260 for professionals, plus the cost of exams (£93 for the three exams any retakes are extra). The fees may increase slightly as the figure quoted is applicable up to July 2019.
