Booking for Dippy what you need to know!

Many of you will recall the heart thumping excitement that used to hit us when we viewed Dippy for the first time in the great hall at the National History Museum in London and we're sure that seeing him in the Nave of Norwich Cathedral will be equally as dynamic! A huge number of schools and academies will want to come and see him so in order to give as many as possible the opportunity, there will be timed, short sessions.

- It's FREE but all school visits to Dippy must be booked in advance.
 No school will be allowed in un-booked.
- Our booking line opens very soon, 28th September 2020
 Just email Debbie on schoolsadmin@cathedral.org.uk to request your preferred date and book your FREE 30 minute timed slots.
- On the day, all classes will walk through the 'Time tunnel' in the cloister. They will then receive a short introduction to Dippy when they enter the nave.
- Schools will have a designated viewing area in the South Aisle and this will be available to you for your 30 minute session (with public viewing separately).
- We regret that you will not be able to stay on to self-guide in the Cathedral after you have seen Dippy due to the volume of visitors each day. Other venues in the city may be hosting special Dippy related activities, so keep an eye on their websites to see what's on offer.
- Once you have booked your visit you will receive 'Dippy pack' telling you what to do on the day of your visit and all essential information

Please note: Bookings are being taken for schools at 1 hour intervals (for a 30 minute session) to minimize contact between schools. Classes from the same school may be admitted at 30 min intervals subject to the school's own risk assessment.
