Course Outline:

All delegates will receive an audit tool to review existing EAL policies and procedures. We recommend delegates take all three modules, but there is also the option to select modules.

Module 1:

- EAL Updates from DfES, Ofsted, Census and about EAL funding
- Effective EAL admission, induction assessment and monitoring
- Essential teaching strategies and intervention for EAL
- Use of INTRAN, Language line and translation tools

Module 2:

- Teaching more advanced EAL learners. Developing a whole school strategy for EAL
- EAL resources (including online packages, bi-lingual resources and Apps)
- Guidance on access arrangements for EAL in examination
- Guidance on first language GCSEs

Module 3:

- Advice and resources to assist in the assessment of EAL pupils with SEN
- Information and support for parents and EAL communities
- Information about supporting Unaccompanied Asylum Seekers / refugees
- Promoting diversity and inclusivity in school
