





### Good news for Norfolk following the joint area SEND revisit by OFSTED

As many of you will be aware, last November OFSTED visited Norfolk to review the progress which had been made since their previous visit in May 2020, when some weaknesses had been identified.

Inspectors spoke with children and young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND), parents and carers, and local authority and National Health Service (NHS) officers. Inspectors looked at a range of information about the performance of the area in addressing the three significant weaknesses identified at the initial inspection, including a selection of education, health and care (EHC) plans, the area's improvement plans and SEND strategy and self-evaluation.

In their conclusions the inspectors recognised the work which had been carried out locally, including the partnership work involved in improving communication and co-production with families. I am

pleased to let you know that, as a result, they concluded Norfolk no longer has any areas of significant weakness in its support and services for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND). There are, of course, always improvements to be made so we won't be resting on our laurels!

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## Complimentary cinema ticket

Did you know that if your child is 5 years or older and registered as sight impaired or severely sight impaired, you can apply for a CEA card? The CEA card is a national card scheme developed for UK cinemas which allows the cardholder to get one complimentary cinema ticket so that one person accompanying them will get in free!

You can apply for a card online or by post and will need to provide proof of eligibility, a photo and payment of £6. The card will then be issued, which will contain:

- Photo and name of cardholder
- Expiry date
- Unique card number to allow validation when pre-booking tickets
- Location notch a tactile clue to help identify and line the card up
- Reflective holofoil CEA emblem
- · A braille label can also be requested

Time: 10am till 3pm


