

DfE - Manage training for early career teachers

The DfE have been making improvements to their '[manage training for early career teachers](#)' service this summer. This service is where schools can notify the DfE of:

- how they want to run their ECT training
- which accredited materials or training provider they'll be using
- which ECTs and mentors will take part
