Our Networks involve three full day face-to-face sessions with one of our Mathematics Team. The sessions provide local and national updates that are specific to mathematics, whilst linking to the wider educational picture. Within every Network there is time to discuss and debate the Teaching of Mathematics based on the collaborative feedback of what really works in Norfolk and Suffolk classrooms and sessions are tailored to the needs and priorities of the network schools. The Mathematics Team challenges the subject leaders to take relevant information back to their schools and empower them to develop their leadership role to improve the Teaching and Learning of Mathematics.

- Professional relationships with colleagues outside of your school or MAT context to further school to school support and the sharing of best practice
- Empowered, competent and confident subject leaders encouraged to debate improvements and developments in Mathematics education
- Kept abreast of international, national and local developments about the Teaching and Learning of Mathematics
- Reflection time for action planning according to your specific school context
- Focussed time to unpick the key components related to the three aims of the Primary Mathematics National Curriculum
- FREE resource to support in-school CPD on a concept of Mathematics identified as an area of development following end of Key Stage statutory assessments
