Course Outline

The EAL Health Check course will offer Primary schools the opportunity to review their EAL policies and procedures, whether or not you have a couple of isolated learners or a school with a high percentage of EAL pupils.

It will look at the key aspects of admission, induction, assessment, resourcing and offer tasters of strategies that work well with new to English as well as more advanced learners.

Proformas of documents e.g. EAL register, will be available and follow-up sessions in schools are encouraged to ensure that schools feel confident to admit and teach their EAL pupils to ensure the best outcomes.

By the end of the course participants will:

- be able to use the knowledge gained to identify their EAL population
- be in a position to ensure that the best outcomes for EAL pupils can be achieved by reviewing the practice in their schools
- have access to an action plan that will inform the basis of change within their school
- understand that in some cases this is the beginning of a journey
- be offered follow-up visits that will help clarify aspects of their practice that they feel need to be improved.
