## Level 4 Award in Supporting Children & Young People with Speech, Language and Communication Needs

This exciting initiative will enable participants to develop their knowledge and confidence in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication needs and provide them with the opportunity to develop a range of practical skills to fulfil a school-based support role.

The qualification is suitable for practitioners working in support roles and is open to those in all phases of education; early years, primary, secondary and post-16.

On successful completion participants will gain a Level 4 award in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication and 6 level 4 credits from Gateway Qualifications. Participants will take away an exciting portfolio of work.

The qualification can be accessed online via laptop/tablet/phone.

The qualification is being offered in partnership with Norfolk Virtual School for SEND. The qualification is being offered via a blended pathway, with access to the online course materials and 7 short virtual workshop sessions delivered via Teams/Zoom.
