Understanding self-harm and suicide prevention in educational settings (Norfolk & Waveney)

Outline

This training will cover self-harm and suicide prevention within the context of schools. It is free for all Norfolk and Waveney schools/academies.

Description

We will consider why young people may self-harm and what schools can do to offer support. We will think about when young people are at risk of suicide, and consider carefully what schools need to do when they are worried about a young person. We will share with you our new sample self-harm policy for secondary schools.

Outcome

Aims of the training are to

- increase knowledge about self harm and suicide
- understand how you can support young people
- be confident in using the NSCB guidance 'What to do if you believe a child might be at risk of suicide'
- familiarise yourself with the new sample self-harm policy for secondary schools

Audience

Headteachers, senior leaders (schools), designated safeguarding staff, school mental health leads, pastoral staff, other school staff interested in self-harm and suicide prevention
