This workshop will give pupils an opportunity to respond to artworks in the gallery through making, focussing on assembling, constructing, fixing and joining. A range of materials that prompt specific usage will be provided and pupils will be encouraged to challenge accepted use of these materials developing their creative thinking, process and exploration.

Be a critic

For KS3, GCSE, AS, A2 and FE students **Friday 15th October**: led by local artist Claudia Boese **Wednesday 10th November**: led by local artist Caroline Wright

This session aims to give students a simple vocabulary of visual language and understanding how to assemble this vocabulary into a coherent story when responding to an art exhibition. Students will record their responses to the Saatchi exhibition using writing and drawing as a direct visual record of their observation, feeling or thought. Within the workshop students will have the opportunity to share their awareness and opinions effectively.
