Children's Workshops

The Norfolk and Norwich Millennium Library houses a wealth of books and other resources that will interest children and enhance their learning. Starting in the autumn term 2010, we will be offering teachers a series of themed workshops for Key Stages 1 and 2. Workshops will last for between one and two hours and will be interactive, using stories and crafts, and can include a library tour and library skills activities.

Workshops with a history theme will use materials from the Norfolk Heritage Centre and the Second Air Division Memorial Library. There will be an opportunity to look at original and facsimile local historical resources such as World War Two artefacts, maps, institutional records, hand-written and printed materials, photographs and ephemera. The workshops would be ideal for children to learn more about local history, or for extending the history curriculum.

The first workshops, to be held in the autumn term, will focus on the Normans in Norfolk, and will link with the forthcoming BBC Hands on History project, which is due to run from August 2010. Our activities are designed to be fun and enjoyable, and to engage children with the period. Through our excellent Heritage Library, we are able to offer access to facsimiles of the Domesday Book, in both Latin and in translation, to illuminated books, and to records of other Norman activities and events in Norfolk.
