This exhibition brings together rare and beautiful religious objects from the Bronze Age to the present day which reflect the long history of religious diversity in Norfolk.

We hope your school will visit the exhibition. You may like to enhance your visit by booking a workshop or visiting a local place of worship.

Our Primary school workshops for Key Stages 1 and 2 will focus on how religious beliefs, ideas and feelings can be expressed through sacred art and then respond through creative activities. Choose from:

Paper Quiltmaking

Use symbolism, colour and texture to express meaning and create a shared response.

Special Books

Use shapes, patterns and calligraphy designs from holy texts and symbols to create a decorative cover for a special book.

Workshops cost £2.50 per pupil. Duration 1 ½ hours.

Free admission for Norfolk County Council schools.

Free admission to NMAS sites for teachers at any time during normal museum opening hours.
