1.0 Introduction

Established, trusted and designed specifically for schools, SIMS is a **comprehensive and integrated Management Information System (MIS)** for managing whole school improvement.

Developed with a true understanding of both school and educational requirements, SIMS supports schools in raising standards of achievement and student attainment, managing their statutory returns, managing finances and sharing good teaching practices. SIMS offers a wide range of specialist modules, which integrate seamlessly to provide a comprehensive MIS package that simplifies a school's key administrative and management activities.

- SIMS helps schools manage student registration and truancy, student performance, personalised learning, exam organisation, timetable construction, cover management and many more school activities – in fact, just about every significant business process a school is likely to undertake is supported in SIMS.
- SIMS maintains real-time, accurate information to support schools in conducting regular and comprehensive self-evaluations. Senior leaders are able to target resources, support personal development, promote achievements and spread good practice.
- SIMS enables teachers to access information, analyse and input pupil data, quickly and efficiently through the use of powerful, integrated desktop tools.
- The solution is further enhanced by web access through the powerful SIMS Learning Gateway which facilitates teacher and parent access to the data in SIMS from home. SIMS InTouch ensures parents/carers and teachers are kept up to date and engaged through SMS and email messages that can be quickly and easily transmitted to communicate important information. SIMS In-Touch is available as an optional module to the core suite at additional cost.

Brief details of the elements of SIMS are covered in the sections below.

2.0 SIMS Core Suite

SIMS Core Suite of software for Norfolk covers the following: Student Record, System Manager, Reporting, Statutory Returns, Alerts, Admissions, Attendance, Behaviour and SEN, Personnel and Dinner Money. The licence cost also includes Curriculum with Assessment and Reporting Suite (see 3.0 and 4.0), Learning Gateway, IEP Writer and Lesson Monitor (Secondary Only).

At the centre of the SIMS system is the child's record. SIMS displays a complete view of the student which allows the administrator to enter information about the child to meet statutory requirements. This information can also be entered via a CTF (Common Transfer File) or ATF (Admissions Transfer File). From the child's record, users can link to other processes or other key items of data (for example, full attendance record, behaviour record, assessment information and exams etc).

SIMS Personnel stores personal, professional and contractual information about school staff, both teaching and non-teaching. **It is fully integrated in the SIMS system, allowing other processes to use the same data.** Information from Personnel integrates seamlessly with curriculum

processes – to produce timetables, profiles and assessment results – and with SIMS Core – to produce attendance and examination information.

4.0 SIMS Curriculum Management Suite

SIMS Curriculum Suite of software covers the following: Timetabling (NOVA-T6), Cover, Course Manager and Options.

5.0 Getting the Most out of SIMS

SIMS Documentation: There is an **extensive range of documentation** that is provided in support of SIMS. Online manuals are available within the software. Capita also provide online help files, help sheets and software viewlets (screen demonstrations) for more popular processes. Other supporting documentation includes:

- The “What’s New?” screen that provides a quick overview of the new features in each release.
- Context sensitive online help, accessed directly from the screen that the user is working in.
- Training materials (training notes and data), which local authorities can use to save time in locally producing and maintaining resources to be used with schools.
- Quick Reference Sheets, issued in laminated format for distribution to schools and available to download online.
- Help sheets offering step-by-step guides focused around key school processes (e.g. Key Stage data processing, student admissions, exporting data to the local authority and School Census).
- The SIMS Yearbook – two large wall charts that set out the key house-keeping and data processing tasks throughout the academic year.
- Tutorials and software viewlets, offering “click-through” demonstrations to show end-users how a particular aspect of the SIMS software works. These are particularly powerful in offering reminders of how to perform infrequent tasks, such the School Census.
