Risk Management in Physical Education and School Sport Primary

24th January 2011 ECS K4/A Venue: The Norwich PDC, Woodside Road.
Cost: £140

This course is aimed at all staff (both QTS and TA's) who teach PE and is strongly recommended in order to ensure that schools are complying with the guidance issued in September 2008 by the Association for Physical Education (afPE). The course will cover all aspects of completing the required written risk assessments for PE and sport – a statutory requirement – using the generic assessment form. The course will consider regular reviewing of policies, procedures and routines and standards in Health and Safety, the risk assessment process, including good practice and safe practice. This course is also suitable for School Sports Co-ordinators working across Primary Schools.

The Safe Supervision of Swimming

19th January 2011 ECS E6 / D West Norfolk PDC, King's Lynn
24th May 2011 ECS E6 / E The Norwich PDC, Woodside Road
Cost: £140

This course is specifically for Teaching Assistants (TA's). It allows headteachers to deploy TA's as group leaders to cover the curriculum swimming provision. It provides support and training to allow a TA to act in compliance with National and local (Norfolk) Specific Guidance on the Safe Supervision of Swimming. The course does not require any practical swimming and is theory based covering every aspect of the safe organisation of curriculum swimming. It is a requirement that any TA acting as a visit leader for swimming Must have attended this course.
