Course Outcomes:

During the course candidates will be involved in a range of ongoing tasks to look at and review current planning – including policies and procedures.

- Candidates will ensure that all appropriate planning documentation delivers the National Curriculum and the four core strands of learning and how to embed these in the teaching of PE across the school.
- Candidates will also put together a full subject SEF which will also facilitate the completion of the Norfolk High Quality PE Chartermark Award. This will ensure a development plan with appropriate targets and for which the candidate will receive on-going support to deliver for the benefit of the school and young people.
- Candidates will also be supported to develop ideas which will impact whole school and where cross-curricular planning can enhance pupil learning.
