

Children's Services Professional Learning and Development

A Menu for Successful Primary English Subject Leadership

This course is designed to offer aspiring and existing Primary English Subject Leaders a **menu** of professional development opportunities. The **menu** approach offers delegates the chance to **choose** activities and delivery styles that best reflect their own and their school's needs.

Starter: Needs analysis, which will provide the subject leader with the opportunity to clearly define what impact this CPD will have on them personally and also on their school. (Please note this is an optional session which can be provided either in school at a cost of £285 for Norfolk LA Schools and £314 for external clients for half a day's adviser time, or at a central venue with other schools at a cost of £78 per delegate (Norfolk LA schools) and £86 (external clients). Main Course: Two half day courses. Delegates can choose to attend just **one** or **both**. Each half day has a different 'flavour'. One half day focuses on action planning and the tools used to support the cycle of school improvement. The other half day focuses on supporting the professional development of colleagues. Dates for these sessions are below (course fee is £78 per delegate (Norfolk LA schools) and £86 (external clients):-

14th February 2011 9.00 am to 12.00 noon at Costessey Junior School – Course Ref EPCS8A (Action Planning)

14th March 2011 9.00 am to 12.00 noon at Costessey Junior School – Course Ref EPCS8B (Supporting Professional Development of Colleagues)

- Preparing for Ofsted
- Interrogating data and target setting
- Work and planning scrutiny
- Paired lesson observation
- Staff meeting planning and delivery
- Running pupil progress meetings
- AfL and/or APP (this includes running standardisation and moderation sessions)
- Developing pupil voice and pupil perception surveys
- · Community cohesion and parent links
- Monitoring phonics and early literacy
