This free workshop aims to help participants deepen their understanding of progression through Assessment Focuses through looking at real examples of children's learning.

Participants are asked to bring examples of evidence of children making progress (this may be an annotated plan, written observation, short transcript of a child's responses, piece of writing etc) for any AFs, at any level. It is not necessary to bring a full 'collection' of evidence.

Participants will then evaluate the evidence for what it shows, what makes it effective, what could make it more effective and the next steps in learning, building up a detailed picture throughout the morning of what progression looks like through the different AFs.

To develop understanding of progression by exemplifying learning from level 1 to level 5 and beyond.
