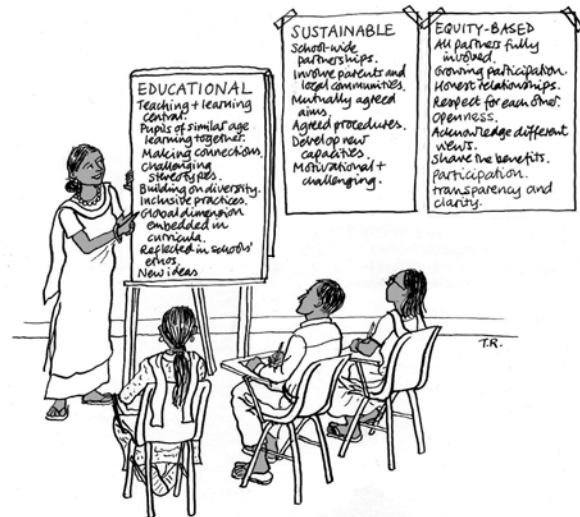


# Professional Development for Teachers
