Course Context/Audience:

The White Paper sets out the DCSF's key principles in respect of partnerships and collaborative activities to improve outcomes for children, including the intention to require schools to collaborate. The new Ofsted framework evaluates the effectiveness of partnerships in promoting learning and well-being. There are particular challenges for primary schools of one form entry and small schools in meeting these requirements - Heads, deputies, assistant heads.

Objectives:

The course will examine the current research and guidance on collaboration, including examples of good practice within Norfolk, such as the cluster School Business Manager. Participants will be able to match their own experiences and evidence of collaboration against Ofsted descriptors. Participants will be able to develop an action plan which will focus on providing broader and richer experiences for children; widen opportunities for collaborative development at school level; enable more effective staff succession planning and generate value for money savings.
