Investors in Families is a national award for schools and settings. Norfolk has one of the largest number of Investors in Families Award schools (61 as of December 2010). Norfolk Children's Services' model of programme delivery, support, training for school staff, governors and parents and assessment has been nationally recognised as the 'Rolls Royce model'. Norfolk LA has been recognised as the recommended model to other authorities intending on developing this programme.

Investors in Families Award is:

- a tool to enable schools to determine areas of development and
- · a framework within which to place new initiatives
- a method for relating work with families directly to 'core' business
- a national award locally organised and held by successful schools for two years before re accreditation
