



Emergency First Aid in Sport - Norvic

It is aimed at all adults involved with the delivery of physical education and school sport both within the curriculum and as part of the out of schools hour programme who are aldready First Aid Qualified. This days course extends their knowledge and applies it in a contextual way to the area of activity in which they are engaged.

The course will cover *Sports* First Aider skills. These include; emergency planning; basic life support; head, abdominal and chest injuries; bone, muscle and joint injuries; and more general ailments such as asthma nd diabetes.
