The best entry will be awarded a £200 contribution towards the future running costs of their group, in recognition of their efforts to promote equality for LGBT residents of Norfolk.

If you are one of the winning entries awarded a £200 grant, you will also be asked to attend a celebration event with the other successful applicants, to say a few words about why your chosen role model is special, and how they have inspired you.
