Secondary NQT Recruitment 2011

Email alert system:

Headteachers and governors might like to know that as soon as an advertisement for a vacancy suitable for an NQT is received for placement by the HR Recruitment Team (Shared Services) a copy passes to Steve Hardy and Liz Buckland who proactively market your vacancy.

This together with your vacancy on the Norfolk School jobs site and their email marketing might be all you need to secure the right NQT without any further advertising costs.
