

North Norfolk's Environment Awards

North Norfolk District Council's Environment Awards are once again open for applications from local organisations such as schools, businesses and community groups who have been involved in grassroots environmental projects in the district. Entries will be judged on how they have made a contribution to the environment, in three categories:

- Cutting Carbon Emissions
- Improving Natural Spaces
- Raising Environmental Awareness

A £250 prize is up for grabs for the winners in each of the above categories, and all shortlisted entries receive a local variety apple tree. A new category, the John Sweeney Award, also offers up to £1000 prize money to organisations in the district who are planning to carry out new environmentally-themed projects, or have a proposal for a project which they need funding to carry out.
