Course Context/Audience:

Norfolk - like the rest of the country - is suffering from a dearth of good applicants to lead our schools. This is true of secondary and primary. All too often we are forced to re-advertise posts two or three times, or for small primaries, to consider the option of forming loose federations with neighbouring schools under one headteacher or sometimes linking more formally with the cluster high school.

Sometimes, the solutions are all around us. Why aren't more women applying for secondary headships? Why so few men in primary and insufficient numbers of women for an interview field?

In Norfolk, there are very few BME candidates.

We have invited people from the National Strategies team - now operating as edsight - to help unravel these problems.

We will look at:

- strategies for women to progress into senior leadership and headship at all phases, including how to produce the right evidence to support your application
- examine the barriers that need to be overcome
- look at in-school preparation for leadership
- hear the experiences of a female head
- examine the research
- examine the Governing Body's role in succession planning
