Tournament Regulations (please retain)

- 1. Entry open to all junior players living in Norfolk, or having opted to play for Norfolk (must not be playing in a disaffiliated league).
- 2. Please report to the referee's table upon arrival.
- 3. All matches to be the best of 5 games, 11 up. Singles events will be played in groups of 3 players where possible to ensure that everybody enjoys as many games as possible and County Selectors have the opportunity to view as many players as possible. Winner and runner-up will proceed to the knock out stage. Players will be required to umpire group games.
- 4. Losing players must umpire next game on in knockout stages.
- 5. All events will be seeded.
- 6. Non-marking rubber soled shoes must be worn and clothing must not be mainly white. Shorts or skirts to be worn. No track suits allowed on court.
- 7. Eight tables will be used.
- 8. The Referee's decision will be final on any question not provided for in these regulations, or in a dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Referee is Dennis Calver (International Umpire)
- 9. All bats must comply with E.T.T.A. rules.
- 10. Should there not be enough entries in any event, in the opinion of the Referee, that event may be combined with another.
- 11 White balls will be used.
- 12. Younger players may also enter events in the older categories

The Tournament starts at 9.00am, however, you will be emailed with an *approximate* time for your first game.
