Building on the successful Norfolk Reading Café © programme, Norfolk Story Cafés © are designed to be used in EYFS and KS1. In the sessions, through a variety of enjoyable, informal learning activities as well as advice from school staff on how to develop and extend their child's speaking and listening skills, all parents/carers learn how to support their child's language development. Norfolk Story Cafés © help children develop their communication, language and literacy skills as parents are complementing at home what their children are learning at school. Cafes are also proving to be an effective means to develop the school/home partnership.

NB. Story Café training can also be offered to a cluster of schools for a day or as two twilight sessions
