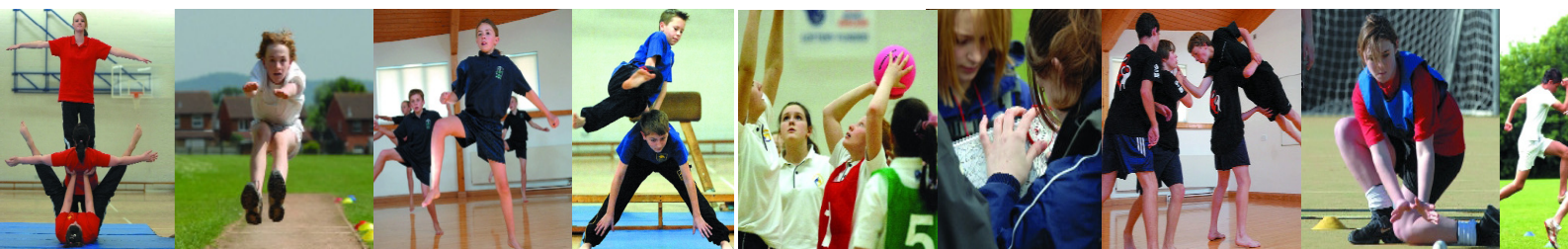


Secondary School High Quality Physical Education & School Sport Award

Introduction

This Award is designed to celebrate your Schools provision of a High Quality Experience and Entitlement in Physical Education and School Sport. This builds upon and compliments the data collected through the annual survey as part of the School Sport Partnership Programme being a measure of the quality of the provision as opposed to simply data reflecting quantity. Schools which take the opportunity to engage with the County's High Quality Award will be supported throughout the process by members of the PE, Sport and Physical Development Service, School Sports Co-ordinators (SSCo's), Partnership Development Managers (PDM's) and other colleagues within the infrastructure and sporting landscape of Norfolk.

The Award will last for two academic years and schools who achieve the Award will be able to use the logo on their headed paper and any marketing material. Schools will also receive a plaque to display in a prominent position to showcase their commitment to the provision of a High Quality Experience and Entitlement within PE and School Sport.

- Achieve Economic Well-being

The process which this Award takes you through will allow you to embed this contribution in your whole school development plan, the School SEF and to be reflected in the schools ethos and aims.

You will see how High Quality PE and School Sport can support the overarching aims of the new curriculum in that it makes an important contribution to helping to create young people who are:

- Successful learners – *who enjoy learning, make progress and achieve*
- Confident individuals – *who are able to schools ethos and aims. lead safe, healthy and fulfilling lives*
- Responsible citizens – *who make a positive contribution to society*

Remember that this is a process through which you will be supported and guided. Take the opportunity to engage in reflection and get to know where your School is now in terms of providing a High Quality Experience and Entitlement in PE and School Sport and use this to ensure that this is the norm for your young people.
