Course Context/Audience:

A one-day course primarily aimed at teachers in their first three years of teaching, including NQTs within their Induction Period. However, in light of the revision of the Agreed Syllabus this course has been opened up to any teacher wanting to learn more the enquiry based learning approach which will underpin the revised syllabus.

Objectives:

This course is designed to:

- consider effective, creative and inspirational teaching approaches in RE
- explore planning units and effective learning enquiries in RE
- outline the educational purposes of RE including the legal position of RE in the curriculum
- introduce teachers to a proposed approach to teaching and learning in the revised Agreed Syllabus for Norfolk (2012)
- give practical advice about teaching about different religions and information about how to obtain further help
- address delegates concerns over the teaching of RE
- look at and evaluate some of the many resources available.

This course is an important part of NQT and new teacher training as RE remains the only locally determined subject on the curriculum and as such few ITT providers are able to prepare students adequately for teaching RE in their first post.
