The Groupe Acrobatique de Tangier capture the danger, joy and urgency of life in Tangier. Moving through a set that floats apart and reassembles to represent the many faces of a bewildering and exciting landscape, the performance takes in the old and the nearly new in search of the city's beating heart.
