The Importance of CPD in achieving High Quality PE

We are totally committed to supporting schools to deliver high quality PE to all young people in Norfolk. A vital part of this commitment is the provision of high quality continued professional development (CPD) opportunities for staff across all key stages.

It is recognised that continued professional development, which is planned and progressive, supports and enhances the quality of the curriculum provision, standards of teaching and learning, pupil achievement and engagement. By empowering staff to really make a difference we are helping to achieve this and ensure that all young people receive an entitlement and experience in PE which is high quality.

Our CPD programme seeks to deliver a number of courses which improve staff subject knowledge, competence and confidence. They build capacity and empower schools to make the difference themselves.

Our courses can also be easily adapted to offer INSET within your school for all staff either as a twilight or staff development day. We can also provide **team teaching, specific subject advice and support, health and safety guidance, bespoke coaching and mentoring, curriculum review, development and intervention, reviews of policy and practice, mid-day supervisor training as well as our nationally recognised support programmes for teaching assistants. In short, whatever your need, we can provide it either directly or by brokerage or commissioning.**

This booklet lists all the planned Norfolk County Council PE and Sport courses for teachers, TA's and all other staff supporting learning in our schools. These courses are accredited through the County Council and are organised by the County PE Adviser with partners as appropriate.

New developments this year and next include accredited courses, either through the local Open College Network or National City and Guilds. In some cases funding is available for candidates seeking to raise their qualifications from level 2 to level 3 on the national Qualification and Competence Framework (QCF). Full details of these courses will be sent to all schools in 2011/12 academic year.

Our Vision is your Vision

We want to help you to deliver high quality PE and school sport opportunities to all your pupils. In order to do this we have developed a series of programmes, modules and advice and support which has been putting Norfolk on the map in terms of PE.

We want to work with you to inspire your staff to engage with high quality PE. Empowering staff and building school based capacity ensures a more sustainable legacy and allows better succession planning. Nationally our highly successful Norfolk PE Teaching Competence Standards (NPETCS) programme has attracted a lot of interest to ensure a sustainable legacy to the Government funding. The High Quality PE Chartermark Award continues to develop and is now fully embedded in Norfolk, and also in three other Local Authorities.



County PE Subject Leader Award - New

This new course developed in 2011 is an excellent opportunity for teachers (QTS) or NPETCS trained specialist TA's to master the full programme of subject leadership. The course is based completely around the national standards for subject leadership (TDA) and sees candidates planning and monitoring curriculum provision, standards of teaching and learning, pupil achievement, high quality PE. Outcomes include a full audit, high quality PE Chartermark application, subject specific SEF and full report on standards of pupil progress and achievement. The programme extends the PLT programme and culminates in a formal award and presentation.

County Swimming Certificate

This course is specifically designed to help support the quality of teaching and learning poolside. From January 2012 any teacher (QTS) or TA working on poolside to provide swimming instruction to a small group under the direction of the swimming instructor must have attended this course. Full resources and instruction is given so that candidates can then work with a group of pupils of no more than 10 in shallow water (less than 1.0m).

NPETCS

This nationally recognised programme will continue to offer schools the ability to develop sustainable delivery of PPA provision through PE, or to raise standards dependent upon the needs of your school. The course is specific to TA's but teachers with QTS are welcome to attend. To further support schools, the costs of this intensive programme are spread over two financial years.

NQT Support Programme - New

Following feedback from last year's NQT courses a new specialist package is available to provide excellent support to NQT's across the areas of activity in PE. Please call us for details. Every NQT will be sent details in due course.

Modular Programmes 2011 - 2012

Norfolk PE Teaching Competence Standards Programme – (Primary NPETCS)

ECS G2 / C

This extremely successful and popular course for Teaching Assistants (NVQ Level 2 and above) to be trained to deliver high quality PE in primary schools, is now in its fifth year of operation. The whole programme is based around a series of competencies, enabling head teachers to deploy them in full confidence that delegates are complying with all appropriate legislation, including health and safety and ensuring a high quality experience and entitlement for their young people. **The cost of this course is spread 50/50 over two financial years, to help schools financial planning.**

County Award in Primary PE Subject Leadership

ECS K2 / B

This new programme consists of four modules which support delegates to coordinate and manage a primary PE subject leader role. The outcomes will support the successful completion of a subject specific SEF, which in turn will support and embed PE within whole school development. This course is specifically intended to ensure effective subject leadership, in line with OFSTED requirements and excellent practice. The course is aimed at both Teachers (QTS) and NPETCS qualified TA's and is highly recommended. The course also goes beyond the previous PLT Modules and enhances best practice. The full programme culminates with the County Award and a formal presentation at County Hall as part of our annual High Quality PE Celebration Event. **The cost of this course is spread 50/50 over two financial years, to help schools financial planning.**

NQT PE Competence Programme - Primary

ECSM8 / A

A new specialist package, the NQT Competence Programme, is available to provide excellent support to NQT's across the areas of activity within PE. This will include, a one day NQT theory day followed by the following practical days including: OAA, Dance, Gymnastics, Games and Athletics. This new course offers a substantial saving at half price, whilst providing a full programme of PE support.

ECS L5 / B

These modules will consist of a self-learning resource for guided self-study. The candidates will need to complete the reading and reflective tasks together with knowledge reviews and school based learning tasks over a personalised timescale. Candidates will then get the opportunity to come together and network at a training session which will also look at putting policy into practice. This new and innovative approach to CPD in PE is locally accredited by Norfolk County Council in the first instance.
