For a limited number of schools, D4LC will continue to be partly subsidised by the local authority. The basic package is for the participation of two designated D4LC teachers and includes two places at the 'Drama, Learning & the Brain' conference on Friday 23rd September (in Norwich) and a termly visit to two D4LC teachers (Autumn 2011 and Spring Term 2012) from a drama specialist consultant.
