- Ongoing monitoring

- **nominate a member of staff (e.g. Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator) to attend ALL the L2 and L3 training sessions and take responsibility for coordinating and managing the programme in school**
- **ensure that teachers and Teaching Assistants attending the course have opportunities to carry out tasks and practise with pupils in between sessions.**

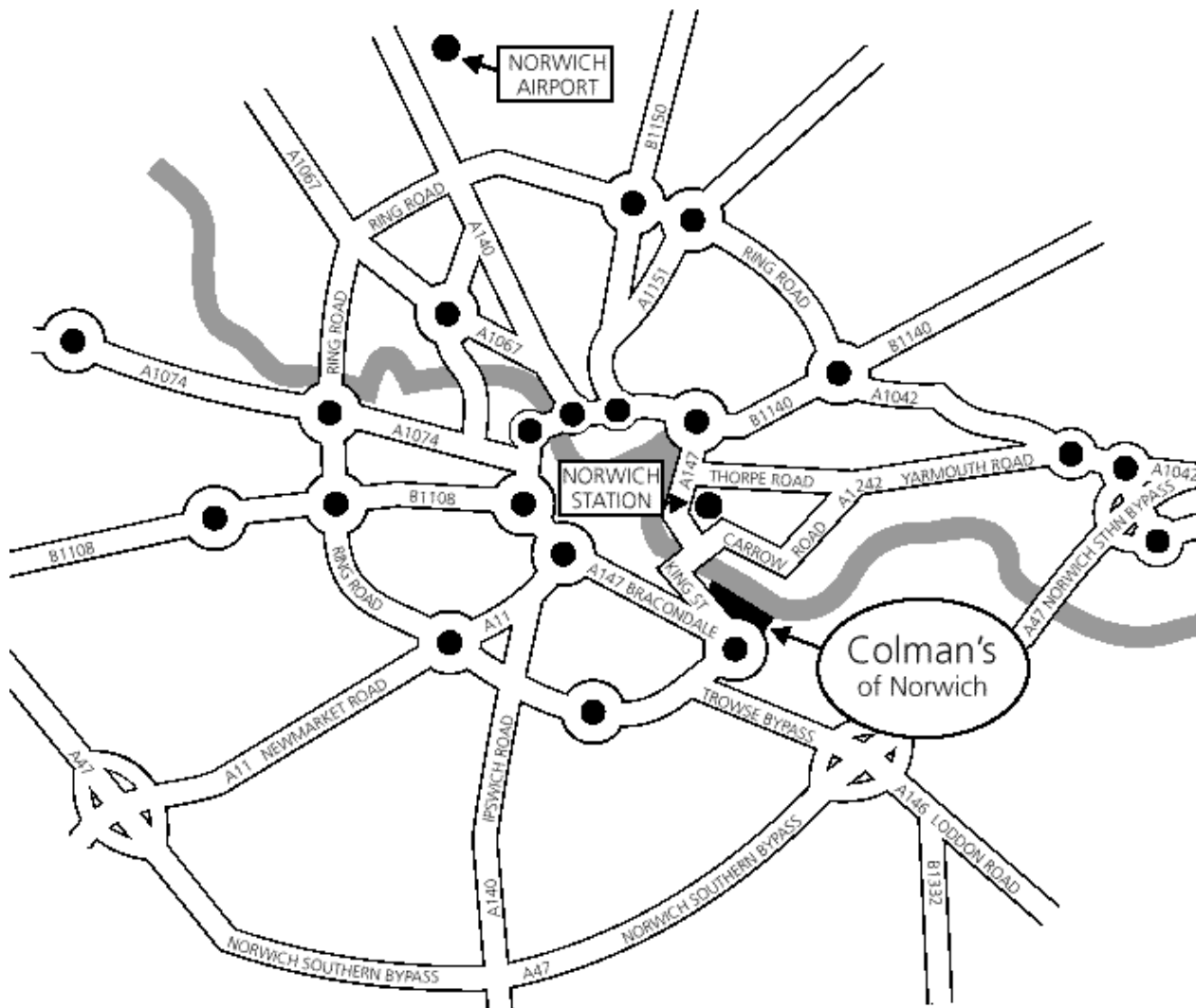

N.B. The Abbey Conference Centre is situated within the grounds of Colman's Mustard Factory



**If approaching Norwich from the South or West join the A47, Norwich Southern Bypass, and head towards Great Yarmouth. Leave the bypass at A146 junction signed Trowse and County Hall. Follow the road for approximately three-quarters of a mile to a T-junction at which you turn right, and travel a further 300 yards to a roundabout. All site access is via the entrance directly across the roundabout and is signed "Works"**
