Digital Photography Workshops at Holt Hall

Spend the day photographing the beautiful grounds of Holt Hall in North Norfolk and learn how to get the most out of your digital camera. A one-day 'Beginners' workshop is being held in September and a 'Further Steps' workshop in October, both led by local photographer and tutor, Julia Rafferty.

The 'Beginners' workshop takes place on **Saturday 24 September**, 10.30 – 4.30 and includes a number of sessions exploring the grounds and getting to know the settings on your digital camera. The aim of the day is to move on from the cameras 'Auto' settings to the 'Program Mode', giving control over flash, exposure compensation, 'ISO' and white balance. The last session of the day will be an introduction and demonstration of the Adobe Photoshop software showing you how to begin editing your photos.

A 'Further Steps' workshop takes place on **Saturday 22 October** between 10.30 – 4.30. The day will include a number of sessions allowing you to gain confidence in using the more advanced settings on your camera including aperture priority and techniques to manipulate the depth of field in photos. The last session of the day will be a demonstration of the Adobe Photoshop Elements software showing you how take further steps in editing your photos.

Tea and coffee will be provided during the day however you will be required to bring a packed lunch. The workshops are £36 per day and availability is limited.
