We work with local schools to raise the attainment of students who are new to English, more advanced bilingual learners and refugees and asylum seekers. We aim to promote and share good EAL practice countywide which is informed by national developments but responds to local needs.

We offer a variety of **advisory support options** and a **regular programme of centre-based and school-based training**. These can be tailored to meet the individual needs of your school.

This year we are also piloting a new accredited course for Teaching Assistants working with EAL students.

We work with Norfolk schools to raise the attainment of EAL students by:

- ✓ developing rigorous, measurable, inclusive and sustainable EAL strategies with senior leadership teams. These can include:
 - whole-school EAL audits
 - guidance on admissions and induction for new arrivals
 - advice on equalities and diversity
 - target setting
 - data analysis
 - intervention planning
- ✓ working with curriculum leaders, EAL Co-ordinators and classroom teachers to embed language/literacy objectives and global perspectives in all teaching and learning
- ✓ advising teaching assistants and support staff working with EAL students in classes and small groups
- ✓ providing specialist 1 to 1 teaching for those EAL students who are new to English

Advisory Support Options

Option 1 1 hour of specialist EAL teacher support weekly* £2270
Option 2^ 2 hours of specialist EAL teacher support weekly* £3990
Option 3^ 3 hours of specialist EAL teacher support weekly* £5990
Option 4^ 4 hours of specialist EAL teacher support weekly* £7980
Option 5^ 5 hours of specialist EAL teacher support weekly* £9980
Option 6 - Isolated Learners One monitoring visit per term £430
Language Assessment School visit of up to 2 hours and a written report £120

* Weekly support is for a whole academic year.

^ With these options, schools may also purchase extra hours of specialist EAL TA support 1 hour weekly at an additional cost of £1200.
