Information for Schools

Our new 'Creative and Performing Arts' course will give students an insight into the creative industries, and the many varied, and exciting work opportunities that exist within it. It is a practical programme which will involve trips, visits, and work experience at creative organisations around the county. It will develop their confidence, self-belief, communication skills, teamwork, leadership, motivation and creativity.

Where and when?

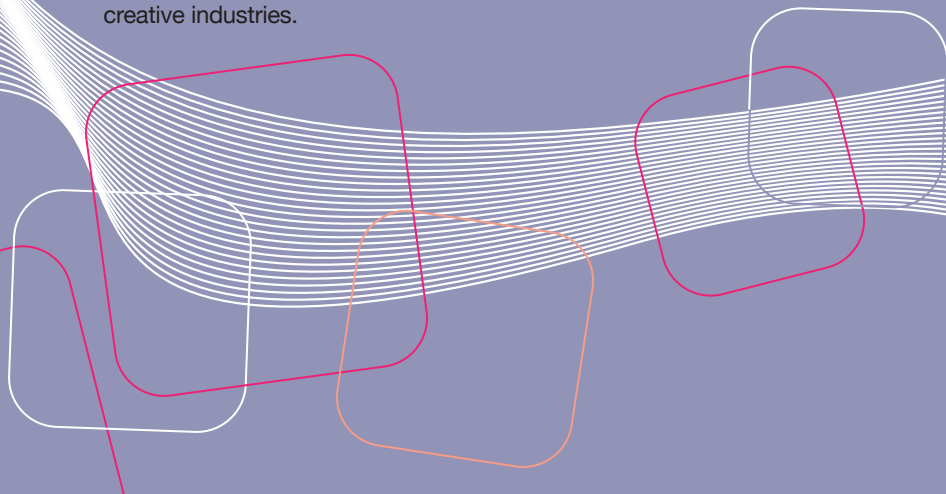
- Two terms: Spring and Summer 2012
- Every Thursday at The Garage
- 9am - 3pm
- Start date: Thursday 5 January

What will they do on the course?

- **Creative Skills Workshops:** have a go at different things such as drama, photography, dance, film/animation, technical theatre, costume, circus, music, beat boxing
- **Workplace Experiences:** get out and about, meet and talk to people who work in the arts
- **Live Group Projects:** come up with a live project and work as a team to make it happen

Who is it for?

This course is for year 11 students who have an interest in the creative arts, would like to develop their creative skills, and find out more about jobs in the creative industries.

Learners will be supported to put together a creative multi-media portfolio which will showcase their achievements.

Through the course they will:

- Learn from artistes and industry professionals in a building that is a hive of creative activity
- Get out and about- hands-on work experience in arts organisations around the county
- Develop the transferable skills that will help them progress
- Develop personally and socially through creative activity

This course is designed to engage young people in learning, to motivate them, and to raise their aspirations.

What is included?

- All course activities, including specialist workshops, trips and materials
- Transport for trips and excursions that are part of the course
- Registration and examination fees for the main course qualifications
- Personal protective equipment required for course specific activities

What will it cost?

Recruitment: Learners will be offered a pre-course one-to-one consultation (which can be at their school)

Induction: The first day will be an induction the group can find out more about what the course will involve and if it is for them

Census Point: After the second week, schools will be invoiced for the following two terms provision in advance
