Using 'eSight' saves primary school an estimated £1,900 off winter energy bill.

To drive down carbon emissions and energy costs Norfolk County Council has set a 25% carbon reduction target for 2014.

To help achieve this target we are delighted to announce that now all schools can use eSight, an online energy management system, for free. The system enables schools access to up-to-date information about their energy consumption and costs.

Already, by using eSight a local Primary School discovered that the heating controls for its hot water were set incorrectly. As a direct result of this simple observation the school will save an estimated £1,900 off its winter fuel bill this year and, of course, for years to come!

Perhaps your school could also save money through better energy management? All head-teachers now have free use of eSight so you too may discover ways to save money and carbon too. A new MI sheet has now been released.
