

www.mayfieldsfarm.co.uk Give your pupils a new experience with a visit to Mayfields, a small farm near Reepham in typical tranquil Norfolk countryside.

The farm belongs to The Countryside Restoration Trust, and is in Higher Level Stewardship, so there is great emphasis on conservation and biodiversity.

Sarah Jenkins, the tenant farmer, keeps six breeds of sheep (due to lamb in April) and trains working sheepdogs and their owners, so you can see not only the dogs working, but also how they are trained.

Other animals on site include a breeding pair of Red squirrels, which you may have seen in the EDP recently, Large black pigs (piglets at present), two ponies and sometimes geese and ducks.

With mature and recently planted hedges, mature trees, and different types of grassland there are many opportunities for environmental studies. Other curriculum areas can also be included in the programme for the day according to the needs of individual schools.
