Developing Your Whole School Behaviour and Discipline Policy

Behaviour and safety is firmly in the spotlight with amended and additional powers for schools set out in new DfE guidelines. With this in mind, it is important for schools to feel confident that their behaviour and discipline policy and practices capture and reflect these changes.
