





Volunteer Assistant Producer Required

The Garage and NORCA have been commissioned by Norwich City Council to develop two 10 minute exciting new performance pieces to be shown on the stage when the Olympic Torch comes to Norwich.

We are searching for 15 of the best percussionists and 15 of the best physical performers from across the county who will work with acclaimed choreographer Aaron Sillis and Marcus Patterson to develop the pieces.

In February half term Aaron Sillis will be running 4 master classes where people with existing physical skills can take part to see how their skills can be turned into performance work.

There will then be open auditions in March followed by a boot camp to find the final 30 performers.

These performers will go on to rehearse the pieces through May and June.

The performance will be shown on the Norwich Olympic Torch Stage in Chapelfield Gardens on the 4th of July with another performance scheduled for the Lord Mayors celebration.

We are looking for someone to assist the project manager and artistic directors in the execution of this project who can contribute to both organisational and creative elements of the project.

What will I do?

You will be on hand at the auditions to organise performers and help to decide which performers get through to the 'boot camp' workshop

You will help at boot camp in terms of supporting the project manager with organisational tasks alongside supporting performers as and when needed.

You will attend and contribute to meetings where the artistic vision for the piece is developed.

You will attend rehearsals supporting the project manager in organisational tasks and assist in the direction and development of the piece.

You will attend the performances, supporting the project manager in organisational tasks and support the needs of the performers.

Who are we looking for?

Someone who could commit to the project in terms of time – who is able to make the majority of the dates on the attached schedule.

Someone who has a background in and passion for performance/directing/producing.

Someone who would like to gain experience through this opportunity, who is motivated and excited by the project.

Film Making Opportunities

There are exciting opportunities for filmed work to be used to generate interest and excitement building up towards the Olympics and for filmed work to become archive material taking its place in history.

We are therefore searching not only for performers but for **film makers** who would like to use this as an opportunity to create some fantastic work. This film work would be done on a voluntary base, with your own equipment, your own editing. You would need to be able to work independently while liaising closely with the project manager.

Film Briefs

- 1. Make a documentary that follows the process from Masters Classes, through to auditions, boot camp, rehearsals and performance. Use individuals involved to create story and interest.
- Record and edit bite size (5 6 minute) footage that can be used on the Norwich outside screen.

 - Interviews with Artistic Directors
 - Auditions
 - Boot Camp
 - Rehearsals
 - Performances
